## **Prior Hall COVID-19 Access: Frequently Asked Questions**

- Q: My badge or BuckID will not let me into the library, but the library looks open. How do I get into the library?
- A: All OSU students, faculty and staff may access the library via card swipe access. Each person entering the library must swipe his/her/their own ID; do not ask others to let you in. More information about access is on our website.
- Q: Who can I contact if I don't know if I have access to the library?
- A: All OSU students, faculty and staff may access the library via card swipe access. Questions about library access should be sent to HSLaccess@osumc.edu.
- Q: Can I still use materials from the library if I don't have access to the library?
- A: Yes. Please see our <u>Circulation FAQ</u> for more information.
- Q: I don't have access to the library, but I need to pick up a book on hold. What do I do?
- A: Please call 614-292-4861 (number is posted on the front door) when you arrive to pick up your materials. Have your BuckID or Medical Center badge ready.
- Q: I booked a study room, but then found out that I don't have access to the library. Will someone let me in when I arrive for my reservation?
- A: All OSU students, faculty and staff may access the library via card swipe access.
- Q: I have a test/class in the 460B Computer Lab, Clinical Skills, etc., but I can't enter the building because I don't have swipe access. Who do I contact?

- Q: I would like to check out an AHA manual (ACLS, BLS, etc.) but I can't get in to the library. Can I still get a copy from the library?
- A: You can access <u>electronic versions</u> from the library website. For print versions, please call 614-292-4861 (number is posted on the front door) when you arrive. Have your BuckID or Medical Center badge ready.

- Q: Can I quickly come into the library to print something if I don't have access?
- A: Our public computer and printing stations on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floors are available for use. A BuckID is required for printing. Please check <u>this site</u> for other campus public computer options. <u>UniPrint</u> also has additional printing options available.
- Q: I have a book to return. Can I come into the library to get a check-in receipt?
- A: All OSU students, faculty and staff may access the library via card swipe access. Please see our Circulation FAQ for more information.
- Q: I returned a book two days ago, on the due date. Why did I receive an overdue notice email?
- A: If you believe the overdue notice is in error, you can confirm due dates for your Ohio State University Libraries, OhioLINK and SearchOhio items by logging in to <a href="My Library Account">My Library Account</a>. Please see our Circulation FAQ for more information.
- Q: I would like to come in and browse your library collection, but I don't have badge-swipe access. How can I come in and view your collection?
- A: As of late 2019, there are no longer public access book stacks in Prior Hall. Items are available for request through the <a href="Library Catalog">Library Catalog</a> for delivery to any campus library or office location. Items from remote storage locations may take 1 to 2 business days or longer for delivery. Journal articles and book chapters can also be scanned and delivered electronically by request, through Interlibrary Services. Please see <a href="Print Resources">Print Resources</a> on our website for more information.
- Q: There's no food allowed in the library right now. Where can I go to eat near the library?
- A: As of June 24, in alignment with university guidelines, food is allowed in the library.
